Western Cape

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2019 season showed great promise with improved winter rains. However, variable weather conditions, with continuous temperature fluctuations, resulted in inconsistent bud break, uneven flowering and set. Followed by slow and uneven ripening. Reds were most affected and overall yields were down. White varieties, except for the lower yields on Sauvignon Blanc, were as expected. The challenges are not without rewards: whites are bright and flavourful with good aromatics. Reds have soft tannins with rich fruit and generosity.

WINE DESCRIPTION

This luxurious, deep purple Shiraz has prominent aromas of blackcurrant, cassis and dried spice with a leathery finish. The palate benefited from judicious oak aging, which delivered a full, juicy tannin structure and good length.

MATURATION

This wine was oak matured for 10 to 12 months.

SERVING SUGGESTION

Enjoy the wine on its own, with red meat or with spicy or tomato-based pasta dishes.

CELLARING POTENTIAL

This wine can be savoured now or cellared for up to two years from vintage.
